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Tedlar

Tedlar can be used on tears in both cloth and Mylar sail panels.

The best way to apply a Tedlar patch is to first align the tear using some masking tape on the front side of the sail. Make sure you've smoothed as many of the wrinkles and bubbles as you can, then apply the Tedlar patch to the back side of the sail. Remove the masking tape, and you're done. It helps to slightly round the corners of your patch to keep them from peeling up over time. For a stronger repair place the Tedlar patch on the front and back of the sail.

If your tear is up against a reinforcement such as the nose or the trailing edge of the kite, your kite may require some sewing work to make the strongest repair. To send a kite in to the factory for repair, remove the sail and send it to us along with a Prism repair form, downloadable from:
